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### WELCOME

Every state contains certain defining lodgings – hotels and resorts that nestle into the landscape as easily as a covey of quail in tall grass. These special places – and there are just a few of them – reflect the character of their state, region or town. Certainly the Stockyards Hotel in Fort Worth, Texas is one of these special places offering superb accommodations and the chance to escape into a Texas kind of world.

The Stockyards Hotel is located in the heart of the Stockyards National Historic District. It is the center piece of this lively shopping and entertainment destination. The Stockyards is home to some of Fort Worth's best steakhouses including the renown Hunter Brothers' H3 Ranch. There are numerous historic saloons within walking distance such as, Booger Red's Saloon with it's famous saddle bar stools, the White Elephant Saloon with live entertainment and Billy Bob's Texas the world's largest Honky Tonk. The Stockyards also boasts Fort



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Fort Worth's legendary Stockyards Hotel has been welcoming guests since first opening its doors 100 years ago in 1907. The spacious lobby of the Stockyards Hotel is beautifully appointed with comfortable furniture, antiques, and objet d'art that create an elegant Old West ambience.

Cowboys and cattle barons, kings and queens of country music, even an outlaw or two have found refuge and romance at the Stockyards Hotel. Patrons have journeyed from near and far by foot, horseback, stagecoach, motorcar and plane to enjoy the incomparable hospitality of this premier hotel.







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The Stockyards Hotel dates back to the turn of the century. In 1904 Colonel T.M. Thannisch, one of North Fort Worth's early developers and entrepreneurs, purchased the property situated on the corner of North Main and East Exchange. Colonel Thannisch built a two-story frame building with balconies on the west and south sides of the structure. The building was the largest individually owned and commercial structure to be erected on Exchange Avenue, housing the Stock Yards Club Saloon and Billiard parlor in the western portion, with furnished rooms for rent located on the second floor. Entrance to these businesses was on the southwest corner facing the intersection of Main and Exchange. An assortment of businesses including a barber shop, confectionary shop, real estate and insurance firms, and a restaurant were located in the eastern portion of the building, their entrance facing Exchange.



In December 1906, Colonel Thannisch began constructing a three-story brick building on the far eastern portion of his property to house a hotel.

This structure exists today. The building abutted the east wall of his wooden structure. Work was completed in March, 1907. Housed in the new building were a hotel, restaurant, physician's offices, a contractor and the Club Bar. The lobby and offices were on the street level, with rooms on the second and third floors. The original wooden structure to the west was retained as a commercial property until 1913 when the building was demolished by Colonel Thannisch and replaced with a new brick addition. The new three-story addition with a basement was attached to the existing three-story brick building, and was completed before the latter part of 1913.

The addition was constructed to appear uniform with the existing structure. New accommodations were added to the hotel, including suite rooms with private baths facing East Exchange. Other hotel amenities included two or more community baths on each floor, ceiling fans in every room, and heat in the winter provided by steam from the boilers in the basement.

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The Fort Worth Stockyards were officially incorporated on March 23, 1893. The Fort Worth livestock market became the largest in Texas and the Southwest, the biggest market south of Kansas City and ranked between third and fourth consistently among the nation's large terminal livestock markets for five decades from 1905 to the mid-1950's.

The first Fort Worth Fat Stock Show was held in 1896 on the banks of Marine Creek near the present site of the Coliseum. In 1902 the Livestock Exchange Building, the Armour & Co., and Swift & Co. all begin building in the Stockyards.

Five years later, the success of the meat packing industry and the annual Stock Show brings about the building of the Coliseum to house the stock show indoors. The World's first indoor rodeo was held there ten years later. The Coliseum held many events besides the Stock Show and Rodeo. It has seen the appearances of famous people such as Chief Quanah Parker, President Theodore Roosevelt, Bob Wills, Elvis Presley, and Bob Hope. Today, the Coliseum is home of the Stockyards Championship Rodeo.

The 1960's and 1970's brought about the closing of the Armour & Co., the Swift & Co. packing plants. With their closing, much of the Stockyards were closed down. This didn't last long. In 1976 the Stockyards became a National Historic Site. That same year, the North Fort Worth Historical Society was organized and the work of revitalizing the Stockyards began.

Today the Stockyards are a tourist destination that gives people an authentic taste of what Fort Worth, Texas was like during the turn of the century. It is a mix of restaurants, bars, souvenir shops and upscale western clothiers. The Coliseum still holds its Championship Rodeo series every Saturday night.

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When you stay at the Stockyards Hotel, you're in good company. The hotel offers a picturesque, authentic Old West ambiance that has been featured in several movies as well as being home to many well-known celebrities, including:

The Victorian

Spacious Victorian rooms have either one king size bed or two double beds and are decorated in soft, relaxing jewel tones and appointed with period furnishings. Deep-toned wooden desks and armoires are artfully mixed with marble-topped bedstands; inviting beds feature white-and-brass headboards and floral coverlets. Brass-based lamps with fringed shades complement the recessed lighting. Lace curtains hang at the windows.



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### The Western

Western rooms feature one king size or two double beds and are furnished with rough-hewn furniture and sturdy rocking chairs. Walls are adorned with artwork or photography depicting western scenes. Wooden shutters are found at the windows, skulls adorn the walls, and lamps crafted of spurs and horseshoes add rustic western flavor.



### The Native American

Decorated in rich earth and canyon tones reminiscent of the Southwest, Native American rooms feature one king size or two double beds with one-of-a-kind headboards and colorful spreads. Accessories depict Native American life. Lampshades are decorated with symbols used by Texas tribes as a means of communication. Paintings reflect images of tribal warriors riding horses or hunting buffalo.



### The Mountain Man

Mountain man rooms feature one king or two double beds with padded sheepskin or wooden fencepost headboards and electric lamps crafted to resemble oil-burning lanterns. Rustic, large-scale furnishings include wooden rockers and prairie-style desks and chairs. Framed prints depict western life.

The Celebrity Suite

First-floor only accommodations, the one-of-a-kind, two-room Celebrity Suite has housed numerous country and western music legends including Tanya Tucker, Trisha Yearwood and Willie Nelson. It features a parlor with a wet bar and refrigerator, dining/gaming table, sleeper sofa, comfortable seating, state of the art stereo system and more. The elegant bedroom boasts a king-size brass bed with antique coverlet, a cozy fireplace, antique chifferobe, plush draperies, hanging fringed lamps and a sitting area with Victorian-style settee and velvet rocker. The large bathroom includes an old-fashioned clawfoot tub surrounded by a lace curtain; a second half-bath accommodates guests. The Celebrity Suite's private outside deck includes a cozy hot tub.

One of the hotel's largest suites, the Texas Suite displays a Lone Star theme throughout sleeping



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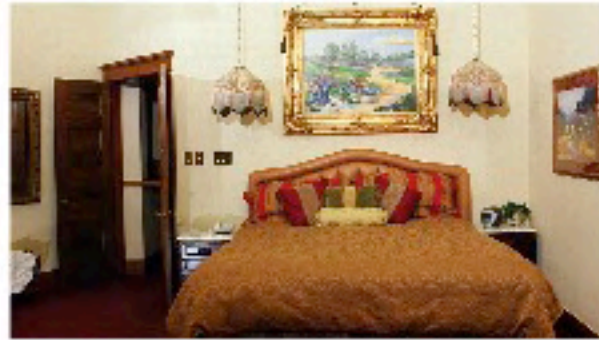
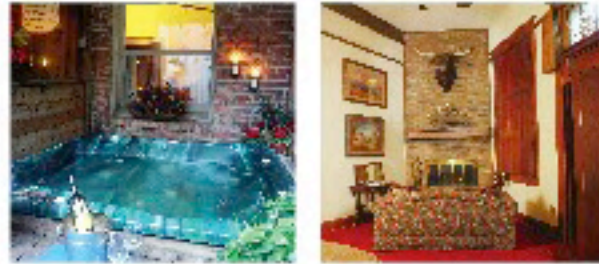
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### The Texas Suite

### The Cattle Baron Suite

The Cattle Baron suite features two tastefully appointed rooms decorated with pictures of cattle, oil rigs and other Golden West scenes. Rustic wooden furniture provides a cozy, western feel. A mounted longhorn head silently stands guard over the parlor bar. The Cattle Baron Suite, which features a king-size bed, may be combined with the adjoining South 40 to create a larger space.





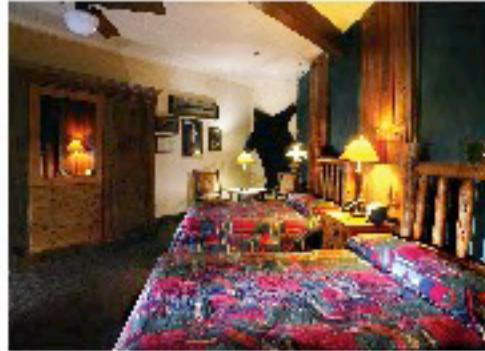
### The Butch Cassidy Suite

The two-room Butch Cassidy Suite features comfortable, rough-hewn wooden furnishings and colorful decorating touches including lamps crafted of saddle stirrups and spurs, "Wanted - Dead or Alive" posters for Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid, and authentic photos of the two. The bedroom includes a king-size bed. The suite's parlor has a sofa that conveniently converts to a double bed, man-sized rocking chair and steerhide-covered gaming table. The suite may also be converted to a single suite via a connecting door. For extra space, the adjacent Sundance Room may also be reserved!



### The Davy Crockett Suite

A junior suite complete with two full-size beds, the Davy Crockett Room features a pair of sitting areas and a spacious, fully functioning watercloset. Furnishings are rustic and western in style, with colorful bedspreads. Photographs of the historic Alamo and Crockett are framed and displayed on the walls along with Crockett's biography, a coonskin cap, shotguns and other memorabilia.



### The Geronimo Suite

The Geronimo junior suite includes two full-size beds and comfortable, rustic furnishings. Wooden shutters are found at the windows. Pictures of Geronimo decorate the room along with a framed biography and other Native American-influenced artwork. Lampshades feature symbolic markings relied on by tribal members to communicate, and an authentic arrowhead is also on display.



### The Bonnie and Clyde Suite

The actual room occupied by Clyde Barrow during his 1932 stay in Ft. Worth, the Bonnie and Clyde Junior Suite features a king-size bed and a variety of historic artifacts including Bonnie's .38 revolver, photographs, newspaper clippings and a poem written by Bonnie for Clyde. Lamps made of spurs and horseshoes light the room, and a gaming table sits ready for a lively round of poke.



### The Cowboy Corner Suite

A spacious junior suite, the Stockyards Hotel's Cowboy Corner Room features a King-size bed and a comfortable sitting area. Appointed with oversized, rough-hewn wooden furnishings and adorned with magnificent photographs depicting the life of the modern-day cowboy, the room also features a steerhide-covered table for four.

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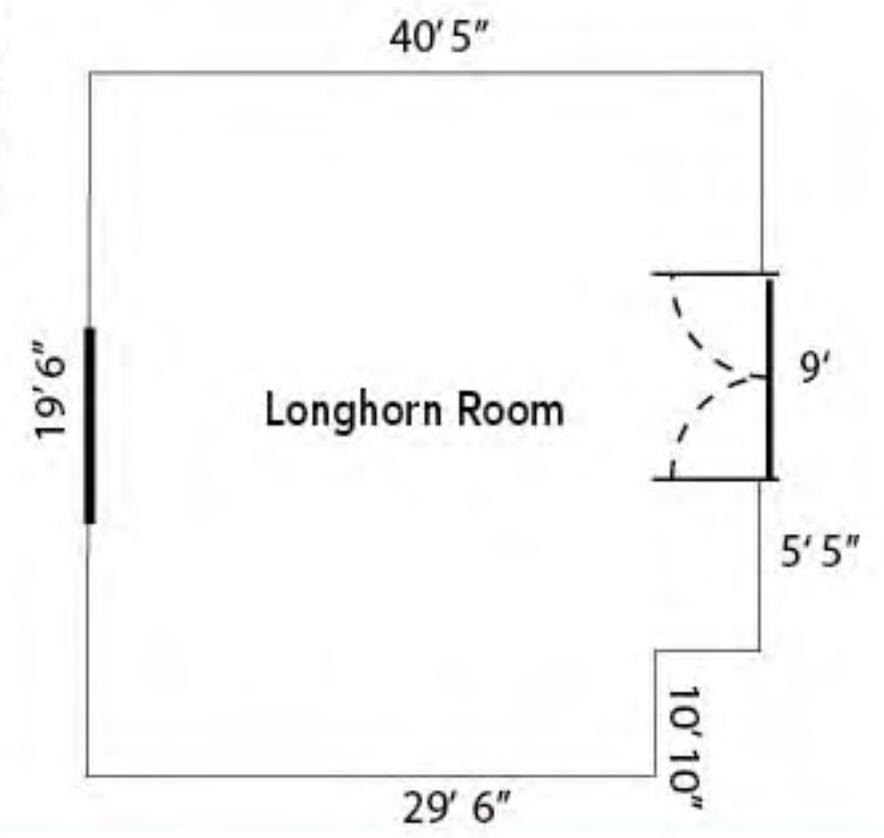


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Longhorn Room

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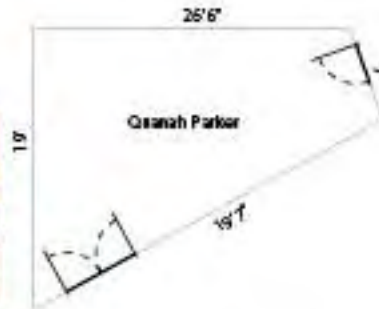

The Chisholm Trail Room is very inviting with its traditional Western décor. It features a fireplace, twin antique wine cabinets and a vast Elkhorn chandelier.

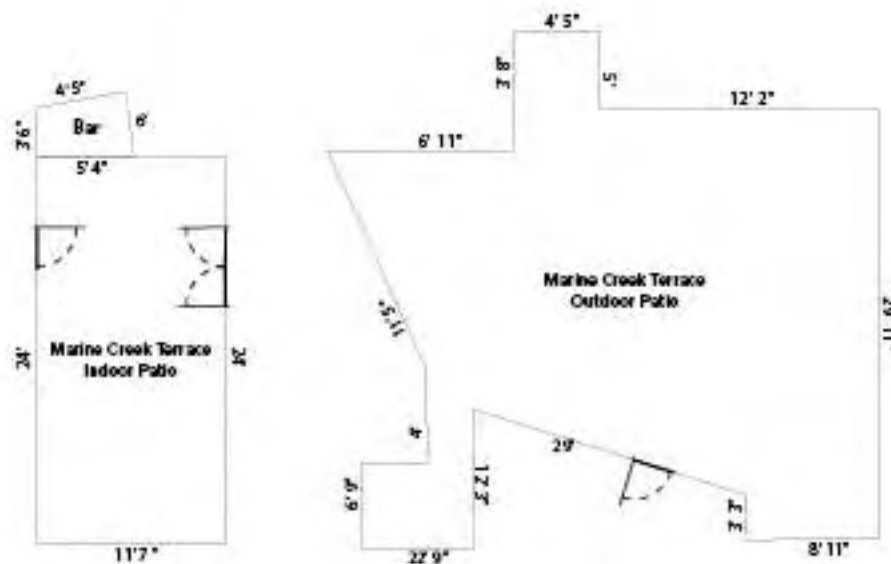

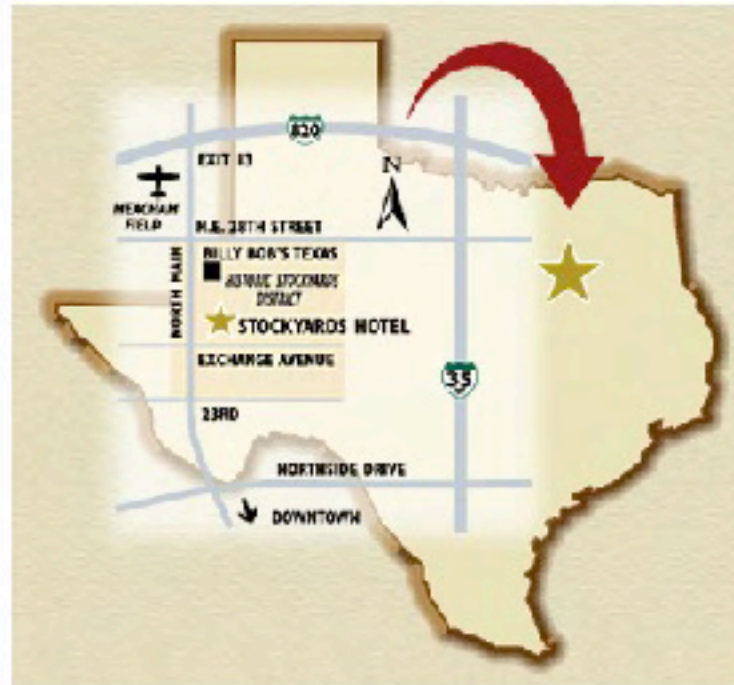

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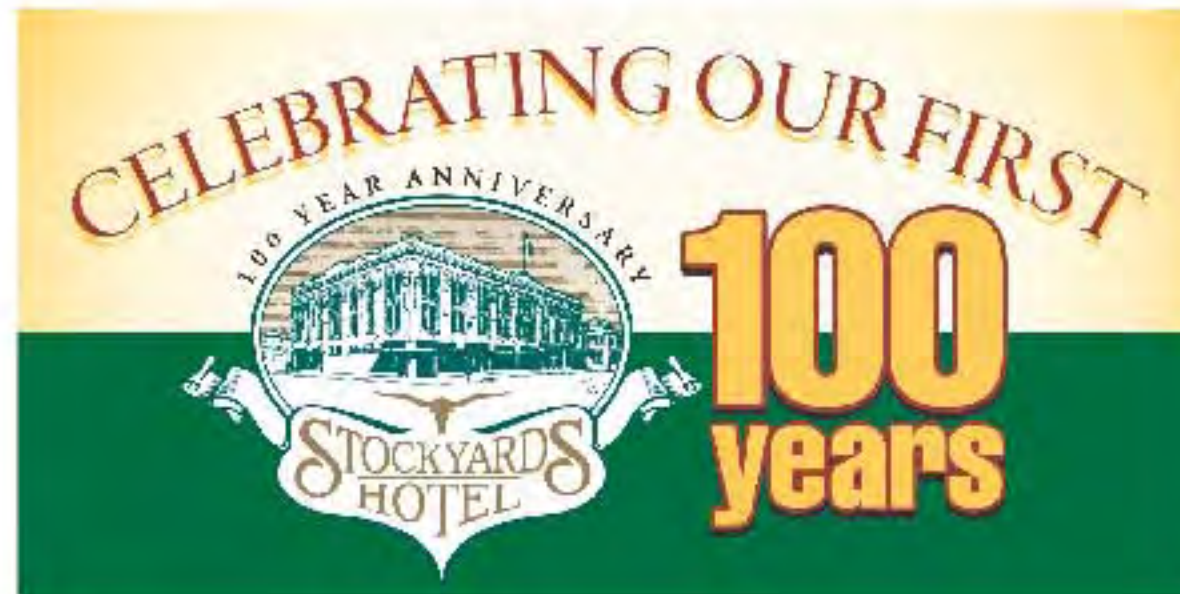
